The draft Interim Remedial Action Plan (IRAP) describes the activities that would lead towards implementation of the selected interim remedial alternative recommended by the South Y Feasibility Study. The objective of the Feasibility Study is to evaluate and select a preferred remedial alternative that would remove tetrachloroethylene (PCE) from groundwater, inhibit plume migration and manage use of drinking water sources to maintain adequate drinking water supply in the South Y Area, City of South Lake Tahoe, CA.
