No one should have to live without running water. And yet, here in South Lake Tahoe, there are times when a family or senior citizen may find themselves facing a financial emergency and unable to afford water and/or sewer service.

As a local public agency, the District is prohibited from giving free service. But as individual members of this community, by pitching in together, we can provide one-time emergency water or sewer service assistance to local families and individuals experiencing a hardship.

Helping Hands Outreach (or H2O) is a voluntary program, relying solely on charitable contributions for its support.
