ENGINEERING STAFF REPORT (as of October 13, 2021)

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- a. Luther Pass Tank No. 2 and Site Valving (Contractor: TNT Industrial)
 - Tank No. 2 roof resumed week of September 20
 - Expect to complete by October 15
 - Exterior coating preparing to install week of October 18
- b. Secondary Clarifier No. 3 Rehabilitation Project (Contractor: TNT Industrial)
 - Contractor nearing completion of mechanism installation and electrical upgrades
 - Ovivo scheduled for on-site training for staff week of October 18

- Grouting floor scheduled week of October 25 with temperature controls
- SCADA Integrator working on new controls
 - Under contract to District
- c. Rocky 1 Waterline Replacement Project (Contractor: Haen)
 - Rocky 1 Waterline nearing completion
 - Paving installed week of October 11
 - Work on Price Road Pressure Regulating Valve (PRV) will continue as long as weather permits
 - Susquehana PRV, Mackedie Waterline (WL), and Stewart WL delayed until 2022
- d. Keller Heavenly Phase 1 Project (Contractor: White Rock)
 - New tank foundation repoured September 24
 - Final work at tank site completed October 15
 - Saddle PRV panel is in place waiting for power from Liberty to connect
 - Interties incomplete
 - Sherman Way Waterline complete but not connected
 - Resume in Spring
 - Rockfall subcontractor requested 45 days to perform work
 - Postpone to 2022
- e. Keller Heavenly Phase 2 Project (Contractor: White Rock)
 - Installation schedule for 2022 will be coordinated with rockfall mitigation work
- f. Blower Generator, Secondary Clarifiers No.'s 1 and 2, and Tank Backup Power (Contractor: Vinciguerra))
 - Underground electrical work commenced week of October 3
 - Plan to install generator foundation week of October 18
 - Generator unit expected to arrive week of October 18
 - FEMA verbally approved grant for Secondary Clarifiers No.'s 1 and 2 under prior application
 - Submittal process for tank backup batteries is proceeding
- g. Diamond Valley Ranch (DVR) Siphon Repair (Contractor: Christian Brothers Lining)
 - Contractor testing of DVR Siphon Repair completed week of October 11
- h. Tank Coatings Touchup Project (Contractor: Topline Engineers)
 - Angora Tank interior roof coating and touchup complete
 - Contractor will resume work May 1, 2022
 - Five tanks to be touched up
- i. Paloma Well Rehabilitation (Contractor: Zim Industries)
 - Project kickoff meeting held October 8
 - Lahontan expected to issue Exception from Waste Discharge Prohibitions for well test water discharge to Trout Creek Meadow
 - Contracting with Farr West Engineers to perform on-site inspection of well rehab

PLANNING/DESIGN

- a. Groundwater Management Planning
 - District consultant (Gnomon) made a presentation week of October 11 to Tahoe GIS
 Users Group sharing development of Drinking Water Source Protection Area Map
 - Groundwater Management Plan (GWMP) Update
 - Stakeholders Advisory Group (SAG) Workshop scheduled for September 29 postponed
 - Staff assessing availability of SAG in light of Caldor Fire demands
 - Staff will modify schedule for GWMP update accordingly
- b. Keller-Heavenly Phase 3 Project (Consultant: Farr West)
 - Consultant preparing proposal for final design and bid documents
 - Staff met with consultant to discuss scope for adding Keller Booster Station rehab and pump station bypass connection at Saddle/Keller intersection
 - Staff met with consultant to review needs for Lookout Tank Access Road
 - Plan to advertise Phase 3 for bid in January 2022
- c. Blower System Improvements Design (Consultant: Carollo)
 - Adding fire system upgrades and WWTP Power Metering to scope
 - Staff intends to bring proposal for design services to Board in November
- d. Tallac Creek Crossing (Consultant: NHC)
 - Staff is working with consultant to prepare construction documents for Summer 2022 bid
 - Staff attempted CCTV inspection of crossing, but camera got stuck
 - Considering installation of inspection port prior to construction
 - Staff installed gravel bags for temporary protection of crossing week of October 11
- e. Future Waterlines
 - Herbert Walkup Waterline
 - Survey has resumed with field survey week of October 3 and aerial week of October 11
 - Pioneer Trail Waterline
 - Staff's first pass at project plans in circulation for comment
 - Upper Truckee River (UTR) Meyers Crossing
 - Staff received survey from County and beginning layout and product selection
 - Bowers/Bijou
 - Staff preparing 90% design for internal review
 - Plan to advertise for bid in December
- f. Water System Asset Management Projects
 - Water Crossings Condition Assessment (See Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment)
 - Water Station Electrical Condition Assessments
 - Staff met with consultant and approved field plan for testing electrical equipment
 - Well Performance Monitoring
 - 2021 Well Testing has commenced with Bayview, Al Tahoe and Bakersfield tested so far

- g. Sewer System Asset Management Projects
 - WWTP Condition Assessment (Consultant: Water Systems Consultants)
 - Staff met with consultant regarding electrical field testing and underground piping assessment
 - Staff is reviewing consultant's proposal for next phase of work with intent to bring to Board for consideration in November
 - Sewer Station Electrical Condition Assessments (See Water Station Electrical Condition Assessments above)
 - Recycled Water Strategic Plan (Consultant: TBD)
 - Revised scope and fee approved by Board on October 7
 - Staff processing Task Order
 - Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment (Consultant: Cardno)
 - Consultant proceeding with initial site visits to all 150+ crossing locations and reporting back findings regularly

OTHER

- a. Tahoe Keys Emergency Supply
 - Proposals received from three consultants to evaluate system impacts to supplying Keys with water
 - Proposals in review by District staff and Keys
- b. WWTP Solar Project
 - Notice of Public Hearing issued October 7
 - Final draft of Purchase Power Agreement (PPA) will be presented to Board on October
 21 for consideration
 - Consultants continuing due diligence for permit applications and site design
- c. Contractor's Forum tentatively scheduled for November 8
- d. Annual CIP Process scheduled to resume with staff in late October
- e. Staffing Update
 - Request for extension to Limited Term Project Coordinator will be brought to the Board on October 21
