# ENGINEERING STAFF REPORT (as of March 9, 2022)

#### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

- a. Secondary Clarifier No. 3 Rehabilitation Project (Contractor: TNT Industrial)
  - District has received report from third party consultant (HDR) regarding grout failure
  - Demolition of grout layer complete
    - Meeting on March 9 to discuss next steps
- b. Rocky 1 Waterline Replacement Project (Contractor: Haen)
  - Work on Price Road Pressure Regulating Valve (PRV) ready to test installation as soon as Liberty connects the new power drop
- c. Blower Generator, Secondary Clarifiers No.'s 1 & 2, and Tank Backup Power (Contractor: Vinciguerra))
  - Staff is working through battery system details and submittals with contractor
  - Staff is preparing change order for Board consideration to cover additional costs due to material price escalation
- d. Tahoe Keys Pump Station Rehabilitation Project (Contractor: T&S Construction)
  - After consultant review, staff has rejected alternative shoring plan submitted by T&S
  - Staff has submitted TRPA Project Permit Application and is awaiting approval
- e. Bowers & Bijou 2/3 Waterline Replacement Projects (Contractor: Vinciguerra Construction)
  - Board awarded Bowers bid to Vinciguerra Construction (VC) on February 17, without alternate bid item for paving
  - Two bids received for Bijou 2/3 Project on February 22
    - Board awarded to VC March 3, without alternate bid item for paving

- Board approved Agreements for payment-in-lieu of paving for submission to City
  - Council has approved Bowers, and Bijou 2/3 is pending
- Contract preparation is in progress
  - Staff expects to issue Notice to Proceed for Bowers by March 9 and Bijou 2/3 by March 22
- Staff will manage the two separate waterline projects as one to minimize staff and contractor effort

#### PLANNING/DESIGN

- a. Groundwater Management Planning
  - Groundwater Management Plan (GWMP) Update
    - Staff presented highlights of the Plan to El Dorado Water Agency on March 9
    - The public comment period on the Draft Plan ended March 11, 2022
    - Staff will address comments received and intends to bring Final Plan to Board for Public Hearing and adoption on April 7 or 21
  - 2020/21 Water Year Annual Report
    - Staff is preparing report for submission by end of March
- b. Keller-Heavenly Phase 3 Project (Consultant: Farr West)
  - Board approved Authorization to Bid on February 17
  - Consultant continues to refine bid package
    - Expect to advertise bid by mid-April
  - With Board current direction for Fiscal Year 23 Annual Budget, staff will include Lookout Tank Access Road in project scope
- c. Al Tahoe/Bayview Backup Power and Well Rehabilitation Project (Consultant: TBD)
  - Six proposals for design services were received on February 11
    - Three consultants selected to interview on March 8
  - Staff plans to select a consultant and bring the recommendation to the Board on April 7
- d. Bijou Pump Station Project (Consultant: TBD)
  - Request for Proposals for design services advertised March 7
    - Proposals due April 11
  - Staff preparing Task Order for Carollo to perform hydraulic modeling of Bijou/Johnson/Ski Run Force Mains under existing As-Needed Service Contract to support Bijou pump design
- e. Future Waterlines
  - Staff is finalizing environmental documentation for Pioneer Trail, Herbert Walkup, Bijou 1 and Lake Tahoe Boulevard (LTB) Waterline Projects to support loan application by end of March
  - Staff is commencing environmental documentation for the Glenwood Rancho and Tahoe Mountain Waterline Projects to support loan application by end of May
  - Staff is preparing to survey Glenwood Rancho, Bijou 1, LTB, Tahoe Mountain and Angora Creek Waterline Project areas to support design in Fall 2022

- f. Water System Asset Management Projects
  - Water Crossings Condition Assessment See Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment
  - Water Station Electrical Condition Assessments (Consultant: WSC/HDR)
    - Consultant has received three responses to electrical testing Request for Qualifications (RFQ) on District's behalf and are in review
  - Valve turning tool
    - Tool has been received and is being programmed
  - Water Leaks/Water Loss Program
    - Staff presented annual Board Report on March 3
- g. Sewer System Asset Management Projects
  - WWTP Condition Assessment (Consultant: Water Systems Consultants)
    - Task Order No. 1C is being brought to the Board for consideration on March 17 for supplemental structural support
    - Staff is planning underground piping assessments, but most need Holding Pond No.
       1 to be in service
  - Sewer Station Electrical Condition Assessments See Water Station Electrical Condition Assessments (above)
  - Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment (Consultant: Cardno)
    - Consultant has transferred Geographic Information System (GIS) tool to the District
  - Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Program
    - Staff is preparing annual Board Report for March 17
    - Truck has been converted from generator power to battery power PC has been reinstalled and staff are hopeful the more stable power source will fix the PC problems

#### **OTHER**

- a. Luther Pass Pump Replacements
  - Staff is working with WSC/HDR to investigate high vibrations seen at position No.1, collecting vibration data and physical measurements
  - Lumos surveyed the floor and pedestals week of March 1
    - Initial feedback is that it is out-of-level
- b. South Upper Truckee Well
  - Engineering is supporting Pumps to find a contractor to help pull the pump and inspect the leads
- c. Tahoe Keys Emergency Supply (Consultant: Carollo)
  - Expect Draft Tasks 1 and 2 reports to be submitted by March 18
- d. Truckee Marsh Sewer (Consultant: NHC)
  - NHC submitted Closeout Report in late February
    - Has been posted to the District's website and regulatory agencies, and interested parties have been notified
- e. Diamond Valley Ranch (DVR) Reporting
  - Annual Indian Creek Reservoir (ICR) Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Report submitted to Lahontan at end of February

- f. Community Project Support
  - Staff has been working with developer's consultants to review system capacity in support of Sugar Pine Village project
  - Staff has been working with City consultants to review system capacity in support of Rec Center Project
- g. WWTP Solar Project
  - Solar Ad-Hoc Committee meeting held February 17
  - Staff is working with Prostar/CORE to update Contract documents by mid-March
- h. Annual CIP Update
  - Board Workshop held February 17
    - Proposed plan being used as basis for Annual Budget
- i. Engineering Staffing
  - Engineering Technician Cross-training
    - One application received and accepted
  - Water Resources Manager
    - Recruitment is underway
    - First batch of applications will be reviewed mid-April
  - Engineering Intern
    - Staff is preparing to advertise an opportunity through Blue Ribbon
  - Staff is waiting for proposal from Construction Materials Engineers, Inc., (CME) to provide inspection support services for Bowers and Bijou 2/3 Waterline Projects from May to October
