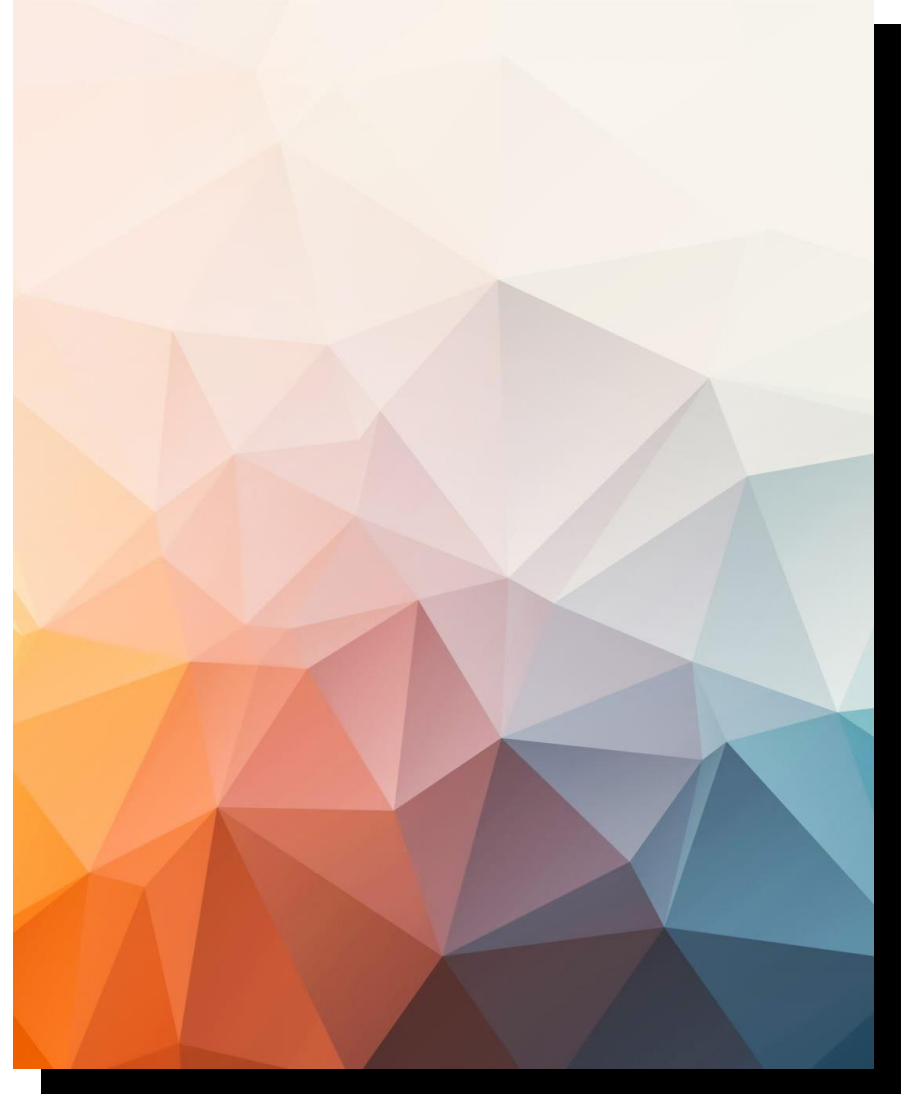

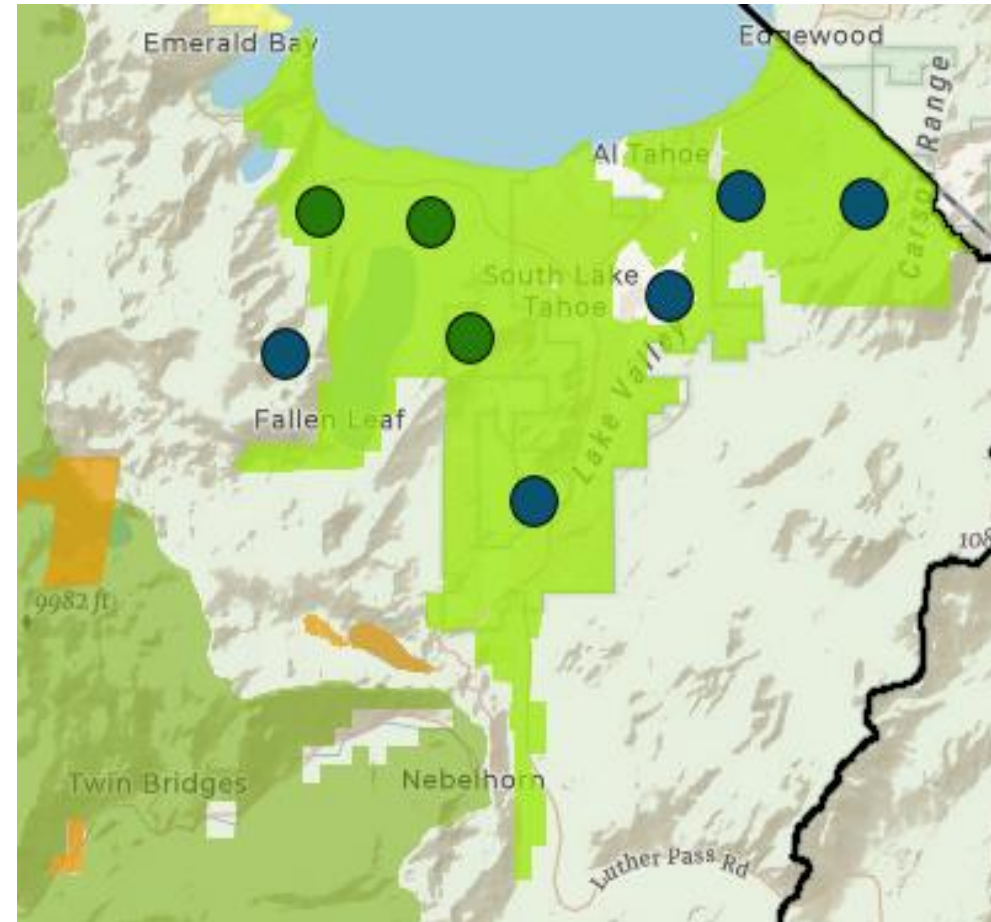

Prop 1 DAC Water Efficiency/Water Loss System Implementation

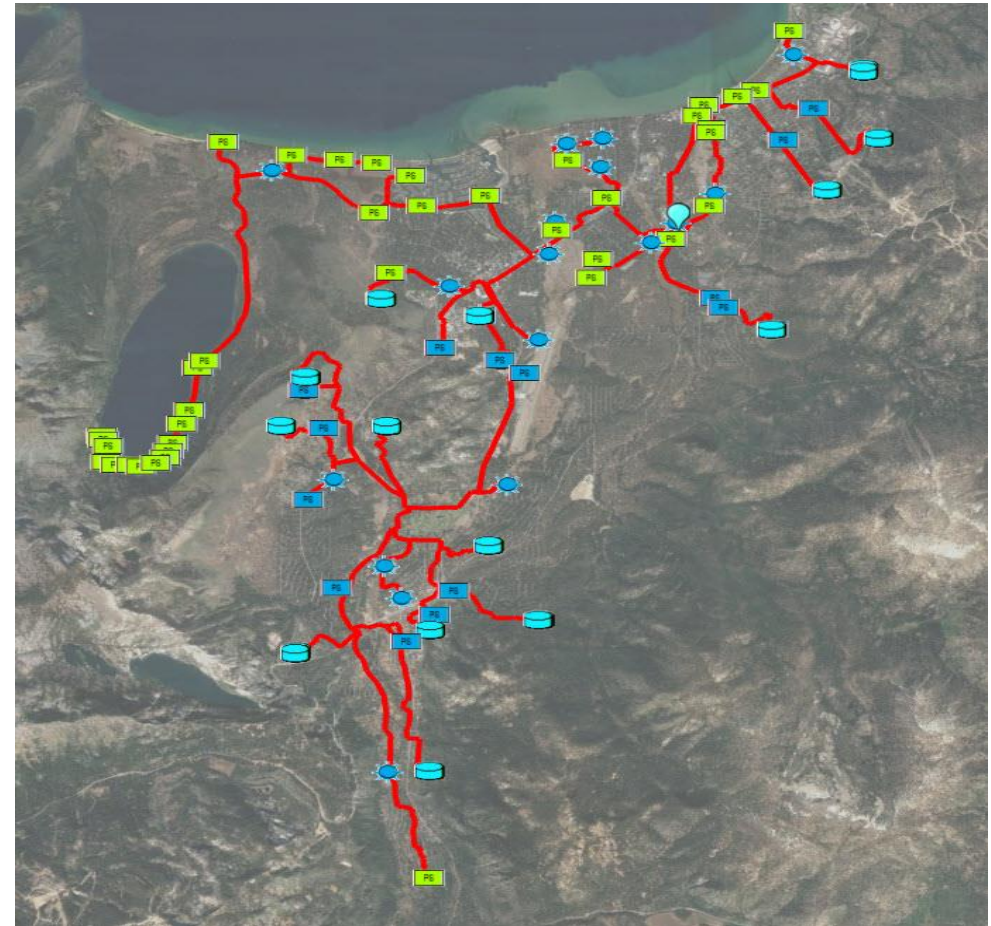
- \$937,901 Award
- Upgrade/optimize water loss data technology to monitor and rapidly correct system losses
- Install up to 3 connectors in AMI system
- Water conservation incentives and rebates





Local Agency Technical Assistance (LATA)

- \$491,035 award
- Funds to develop a plan to bring broadband access to underserved areas within STPUD's service territory
- Plan will be used to facilitate the construction of broadband network project
